This procedure allows us to file a Mechanical Lien on the property we are performing work on in the event that we are not paid. **THIS IS NOT A LIEN**. It is nothing more than a Notice that if we are not paid, we reserve the right to file a lien.

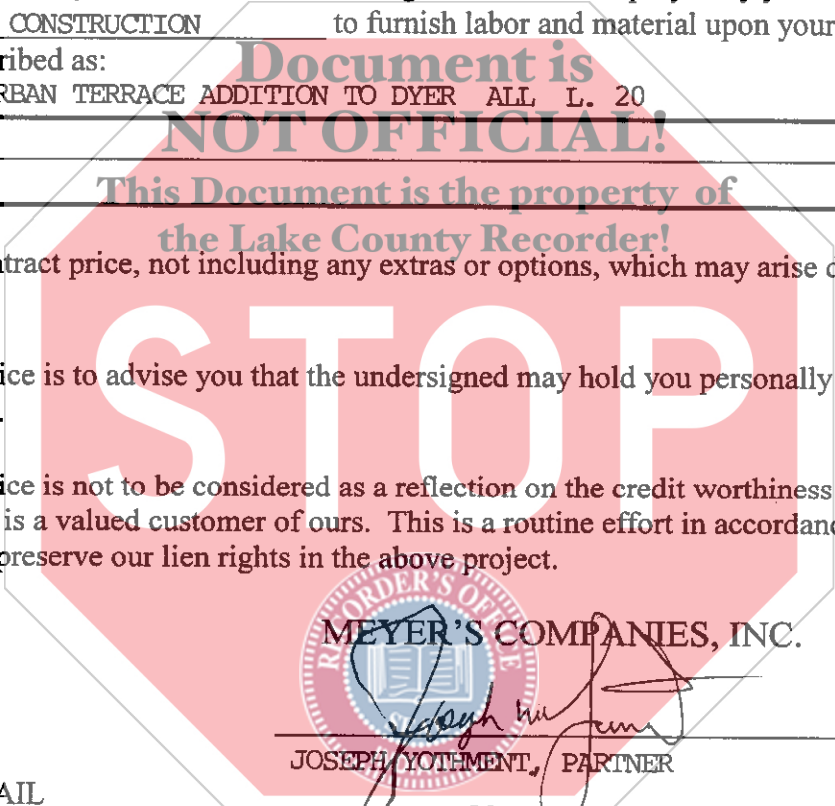
