Any liability under this bond shall commence on the 11th day of December, 2007 and end one full calendar year thereafter.

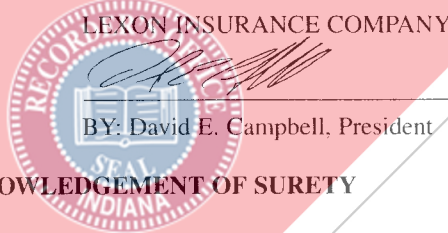

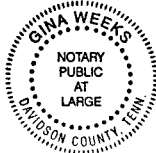
