The Surety shall not be discharged from any liability already incurred under this bond, or which shall accrue hereunder before the expiration of the ten day period.

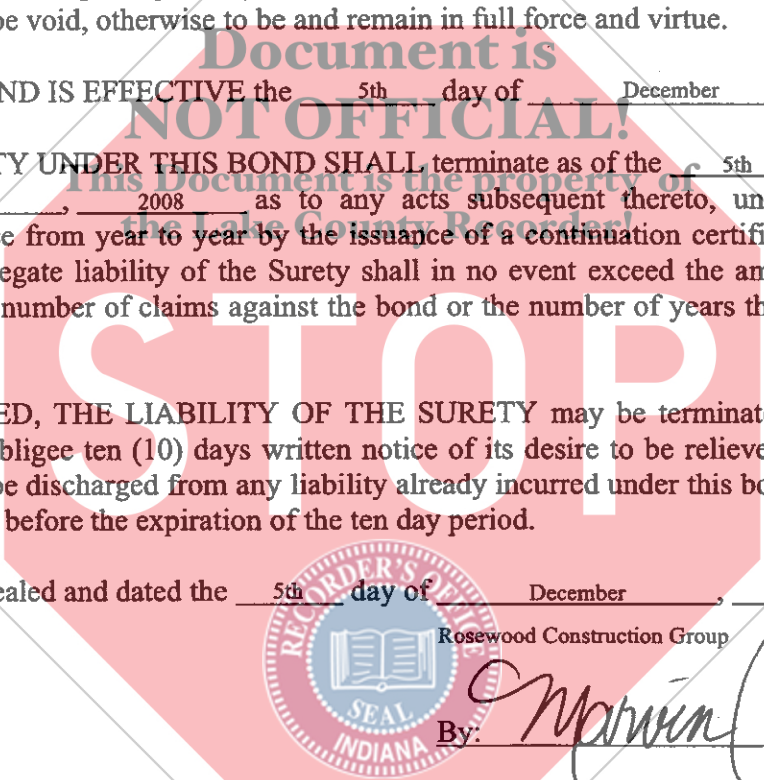
