BY THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY, I name an attorney-in-fact with power to act on my behalf pursuant to IC 30-5, as it exists now and is amended in the future.

1. ATTORNEY-IN-FACT As my attorney-in-fact, I name my husband, Frank A. Pastor.

1.01 SUCCESSOR If my original attorney-in-fact fails or ceases to serve as my attorney-in-fact, I name Debra Greener and Diana Watts as my successor attorneys-in-fact, acting collectively. If either of these individuals are unwilling or unable to serve, the remaining individual may continue to act as my successor attorney-in-fact.

1.02 LIABILITY LIMITED My attorney-in-fact shall only be liable for actions undertaken in bad faith.

1.03 FEE My attorney-in-fact shall be entitled to a reasonable fee for services provided as my attorney-in-fact.

2. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY This power of attorney shall be effective immediately upon signing by me.

3. POWERS I give to my attorney-in-fact or any successor attorney-in-fact, the powers specified in this section to be used on my behalf, PROVIDED that my attorney-in-fact shall not have any power which would cause my attorney-in-fact to be treated as the owner of any interest in my property, specifically retained interests in property given to me by the attorney-in-fact, and which would cause that property to be taxed as owned by the attorney-in-fact. In addition, no attorney-in-fact appointed under this document shall have the power to amend or revoke any trusts, wills, or other estate planning documents I have created or to take any steps which will frustrate or defeat my intentions as set forth in those documents. THE LETTERS "IC" REFER TO THE INDIANA CODE WHICH IS A COMPILATION OF ALL OF THE INDIANA STATUTES.

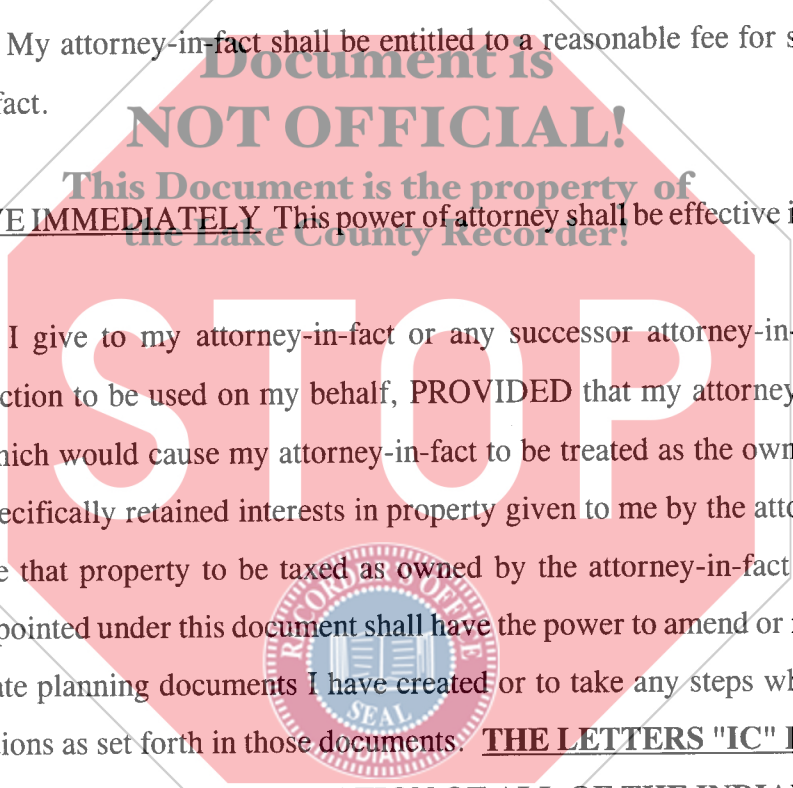
3.01 REAL PROPERTY Authority with respect to real property transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-2.

3.02 TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY Authority with respect to tangible personal

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property pursuant to IC 30-5-5-3.

3.03 BOND, SHARE, AND COMMODITY Authority with respect to bond, share, and commodity transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-4.

3.04 BANKING Authority with respect to banking transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-5.

3.05 BUSINESS Authority with respect to business operating transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-6.

3.06 INSURANCE Authority with respect to insurance transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-7 provided that references in IC 30-5-5-7(a)(2) and (3) to "section 8" are changed to "section 9".

3.07 GIFTS Authority with respect to gift transactions pursuant to IC 30-5-5-9.

3.08 CLAIMS AND LITIGATION Authority with respect to claims and litigation pursuant to IC 30-5-5-11.

3.09 FAMILY MAINTENANCE Authority with respect to family maintenance pursuant to IC 30-5-5-12.

3.10 RECORDS, REPORTS, AND STATEMENTS Authority with respect to records, reports, and statements pursuant to IC 30-5-5-14 including the power to execute on my behalf any specific power of attorney required by any taxing authority to allow my attorney-in-fact to act on my behalf before that taxing authority on any return or issue.


3.11 HEALTH CARE REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTMENT I have created a separate Health Care Representative Appointment document naming an individual or individuals with authority to act for me in all matters of health care in accordance with IC 16-36-1.

3.12 QUALIFIED PLANS Each of my Agents shall have the power to treat all interests which I may have in employee benefit trusts as described in IC 30-4-3-2(c), nonqualified deferred compensation arrangements and Individual Retirement Accounts and Annuities as beneficiary transactions coming within the scope of IC 30-5-5-8.

3.13 ANATOMICAL GIFTS, AUTOPSIES, OR REMAINS DISPOSITION Authority to: (A) make an anatomical gift on behalf of the principal; (b) authorize an autopsy of the principal's remains; or (c) direct the disposition of the principal's remains pursuant to IC 30-5-7-6.

4. SUPERSEDES PRIOR POWERS OF ATTORNEY This power of attorney supersedes all other powers of attorney I may have executed prior to the date of this power of attorney.
5. GUARDIAN If protective proceedings are instituted on my behalf or a guardian is requested to act on my behalf, I name my attorney-in-fact to act on my behalf or as my guardian.
6. TERMINATION ON DEATH Without regard to my mental or physical condition, this power of attorney shall continue in effect until revoked or until my death whichever occurs first.


