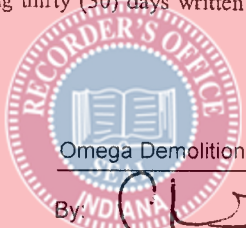

This bond may be canceled and the Surety relieved of all further liability hereunder by the surety's giving thirty (30) days written notice thereof to the Principal and Oblige.



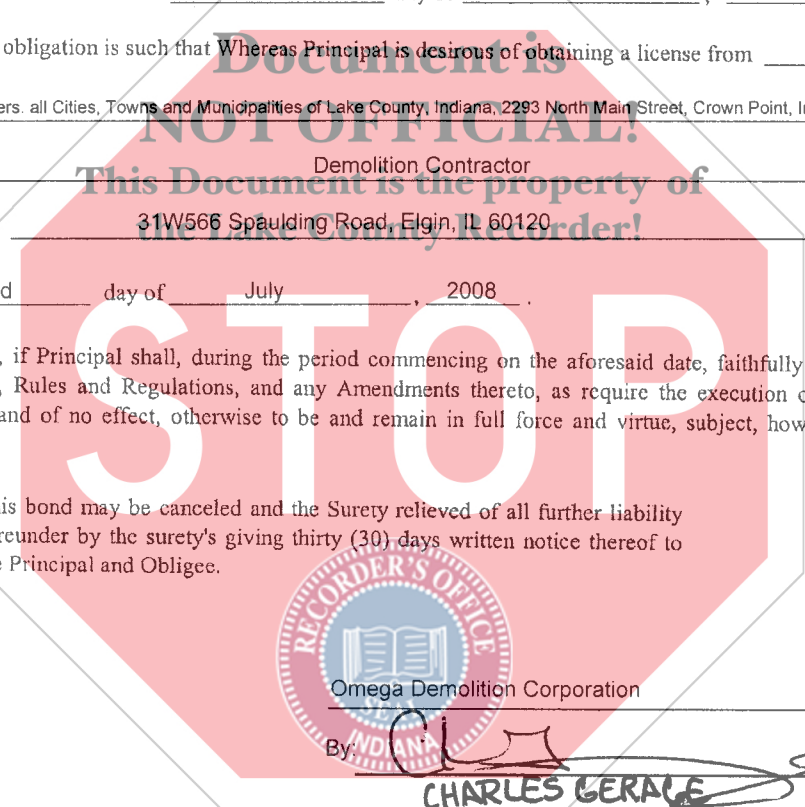

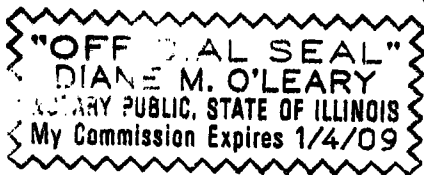
