- 2. That the allegations petitioners petition for dissolution of marriage are true and she is entitled to the relief requested therein
  - 3. That the petitioner is not now pregnant.
- 4. That the marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken and should be dissolved, restoring the parties to the status of single persons.
- 5. That the parties have entered into a written Property Settlement and Maintenance Agreement dated the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2007, which the Court finds was entered into fairly, is equitable and which the Court now approves.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court as follows: cument is the property of

- 1. That the marriage of the parties is hereby dissolved, and the parties are restored to the status of single persons.
- 2. The Court has considered the requirements and standard terminology provided in part 838 of Title 5, Code of Federal Regulations. The terminology used in the provisions of this Decree that concern benefits under the Civil Service Retirement System are governed by the standard conventions established in that part.
- 3. Respondent is eligible for retirement benefits under the Civil Service Retirement System based on employment with the United States Government. Petitioner is entitled to fifty

percent (50%) of Respondent's gross monthly annuity under the Civil Service Retirement System. The United States Office of Personnel is directed to pay Petitioner's share directly to the Petitioner.

- 4. Under section 8341(h) (1) of Title 5, United States Code, Petitioner is awarded the maximum possible former spouse survivor annuity under the Civil Service Retirement System.
- 5. Petitioner (Sheila M. Sawin, SSN: 379-60-1080; 10060 Prairie Knoll Court, St. John, IN 46373), is awarded 50% of Civilian Thrift Savings Plan of the Petitioner (Douglass K. Sawin, SSN 227-70-9883, 4022 West 79<sup>th</sup> Court, Apt. 11, Merrillville, IN 46410) as of the date of this Decree.
- Maintenance Agreement entered into between the parties on the day of 2007, is hereby approved by the Court, made and order of the County, and incorporated into this Dissolution Decree by reference. Should the terms of the Property and Settlement and Maintenance Agreement conflict in any way with the terms of this Dissolution Decree, the terms of the Property and Settlement and Maintenance Agreement, being more specific, shall control.
