## EXHIBIT A

Parcel 1: A part of Lot Number One (1) of Five (5) Acre lots, in Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty-Five (35) North, Range Eight (8) West of the Second Principal Meridian (2<sup>nd</sup> P.M.), described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the North line of the highway known as the "Lincoln Highway" and the Southwesterly line of the right-of-way of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad (formerly the Cincinnati Richmond and Muncie Railroad); running thence West, along the North line of said highway, One Hundred feet (100'); running thence North; at right angles to said highway, to the said Southwesterly line of said Railroad right of way; running thence Southeasterly, along said Railroad right-of-way line, to the place of beginning; also, all that part of said "Lincoln Highway" lying between the lot above described and the South line of said Lot 1, Lake County, Indiana, EXCEPTING therefrom the following land deeded to State of Indiana described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the North line of Lincoln Highway as the same is now laid out and established, with the Southwesterly line of the right of way of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad Company; thence Northwesterly along said right of way line, 10 feet; thence Southerly 8 feet to a point on the North line of the Lincoln Highway, 12 feet West of the point of beginning; thence East 12 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to all legal rights-of-ways.

Parcel 2: A part of Lot One (1) of Five (5) Acre Lots in Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty-Five (35) North, Range 8 West of the Second Principal Meridian (2<sup>nd</sup> P.M.) described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north line of the (old) Lincoln Highway (now known as State Road #330), which is One Hundred Feet (100') West of the intersection of the North line of said Highway with the Southwesterly line of the right-of-way of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad, and thence continuing West along the North line of said Highway Twenty feet (20') thence North at right angles to said Highway to the Southwesterly line of said railroad right-of-way; thence Southeasterly along the said railroad right-of-way line to a point directly North (and at right angles from) the point of commencement, thence South to the point of commencement, Lake County, Indiana.
