Until April 13, 2010, or until the date of expiration of any Continuation Certificate

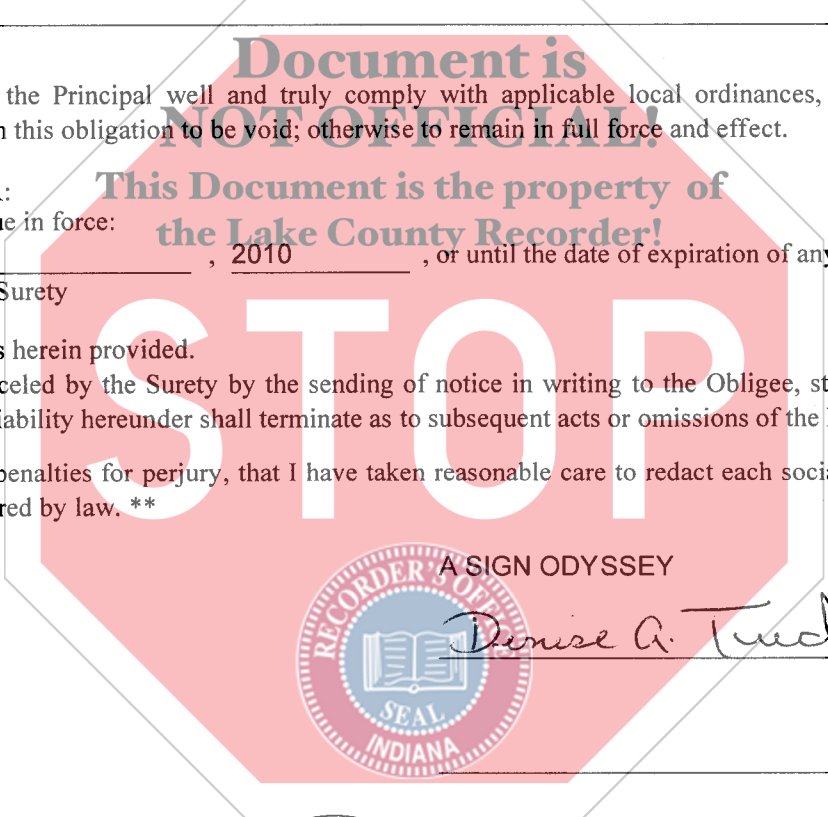
