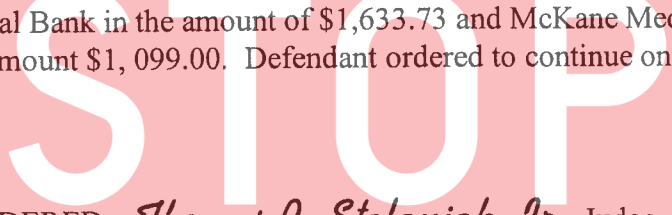

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Sabrina Hancy. The defendant appears in person with Deputy Public Defender Noah Holscomb, Jane Renfrow reporting. Hearing held regarding the defendant's ability to become gainfully employed. The court having reviewed the Presentence Investigation Report in cause 45G04-0812-FD-00139, court finds that the defendant does not presently have the ability to pay restitution nor to become gainfully employed. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties the court enters judgment for damages to Vyto's Pharmacy in the amount of \$1,478.70, Tires R Us in the amount of \$1,817.79, Citizens Financial Bank in the amount of \$1,633.73 and McKane Medical and Hospital Inc. in the amount \$1,099.00. Defendant ordered to continue on probation.
