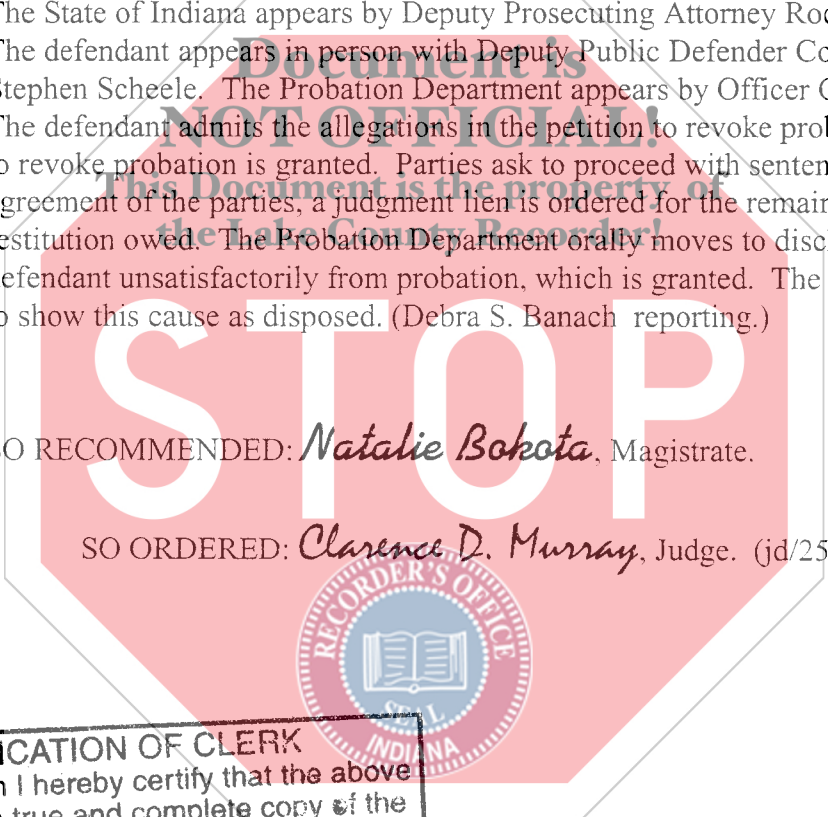
ORDER

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Rochelle Moody. The defendant appears in person with Deputy Public Defender Corinth Bishop, for Stephen Scheele. The Probation Department appears by Officer Gisela Thielbar. The defendant admits the allegations in the petition to revoke probation. Petition to revoke probation is granted. Parties ask to proceed with sentencing. By agreement of the parties, a judgment lien is ordered for the remaining balance of restitution owed. The Probation Department orally moves to discharge the defendant unsatisfactorily from probation, which is granted. The clerk is directed to show this cause as disposed. (Debra S. Banach reporting.)

RESTITUTION \$11,390.00

The sentence of imprisonment is suspended.

The defendant is placed on probation for eighteen (18) months under the terms and conditions of the court's probation agreement. The court imposes probation fees as determined and assessed by the Probation Department. Additional conditions of probation are as follows:

1. Obtain/maintain gainful employment; and
2. Pay restitution in the amount of Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Seventy-nine dollars (~~\$14,179.00~~) to Indiana Insurance, P.O. Box 6057, Indianapolis, IN 46206-6057, Attention: Karen Sobek, Claim No. 402761960.

The Court will enter judgment of conviction as a Class A Misdemeanor, upon satisfactory completion of probation upon the filing of the appropriate petition.

The defendant is to receive credit for one (1) day spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus one (1) day of good time credit as provided by law for a total of 2 days credit toward the sentence of imprisonment.

The defendant shall pay a court costs fee.

The bond is ordered applied in full toward restitution upon payment of cost.

The defendant has been advised of his post-conviction relief rights and appeal rights.

The defendant is remanded to supervision of the Probation Department for execution of the judgment of the court.
