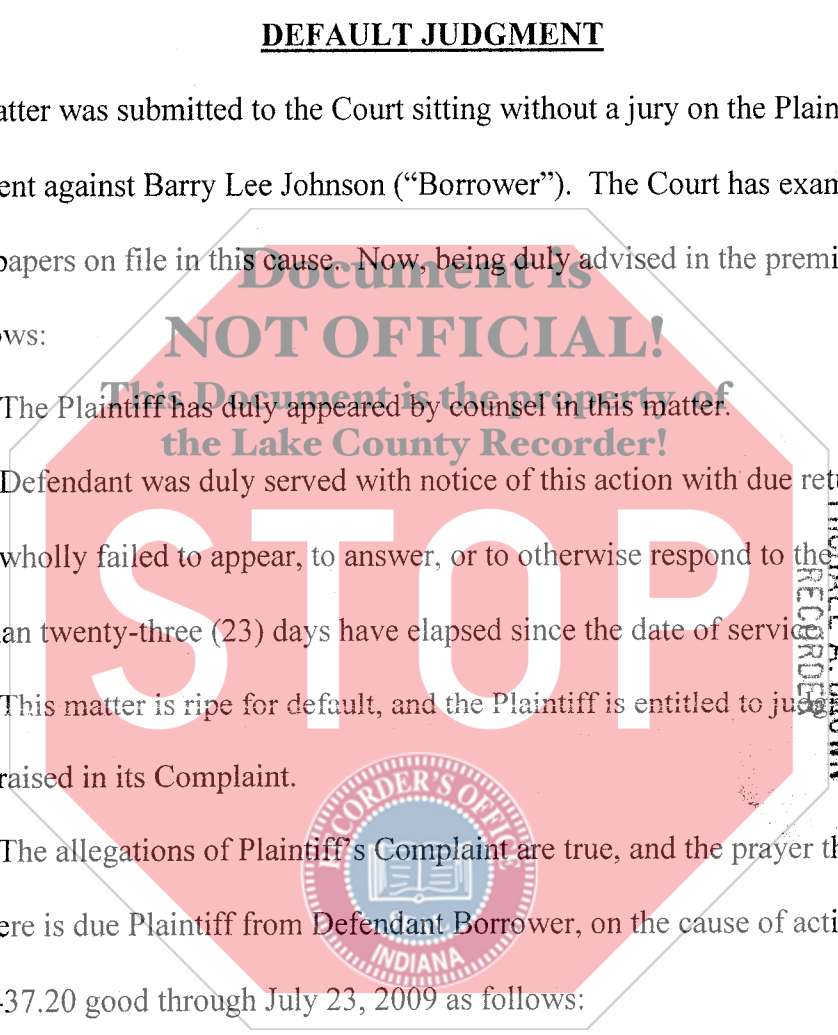

**DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

This matter was submitted to the Court sitting without a jury on the Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment against Barry Lee Johnson ("Borrower"). The Court has examined the pleadings and papers on file in this cause. Now, being duly advised in the premises, the Court FINDS as follows:

1. The Plaintiff has duly appeared by counsel in this matter.
2. Defendant was duly served with notice of this action with due return. He said Defendant has wholly failed to appear, to answer, or to otherwise respond to the Complaint though more than twenty-three (23) days have elapsed since the date of service.
3. This matter is ripe for default, and the Plaintiff is entitled to judgment by default on every issue raised in its Complaint.
4. The allegations of Plaintiff's Complaint are true, and the prayer thereof should be granted, and there is due Plaintiff from Defendant Borrower, on the cause of action sued upon, the sum of \$7,437.20 good through July 23, 2009 as follows:

plus costs and attorney fees. Interest continues to accrue on that sum at the note rate.

The Plaintiff's Retail Installment Contract provide for Plaintiff's attorneys fees, and a reasonable fee for Plaintiff's attorney is \$750.00 as shown in the affidavit heretofore filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. The Plaintiff is hereby granted judgment in the sum of \$7,437.20 against Defendant Borrower, Barry Lee Johnson together with pre-judgment interest at the note rate and post-judgment interest at the applicable rate of 8% until the Judgment is paid in full, in addition to any further expenses advanced by the Plaintiff and additional reasonable attorney fees, all without relief from valuation or appraisal laws, together with the costs of this action.

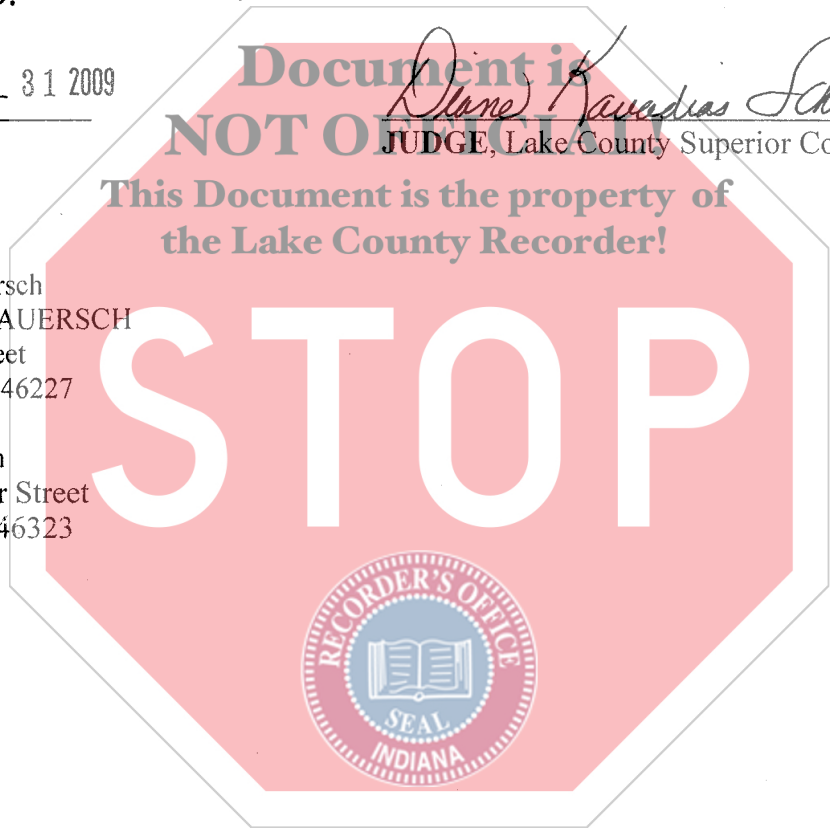
