LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee, 1 Federal Street, 3rd floor, Boston, MA 02110, hereby constitutes and appoints each of JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association (the "Servicer") and Chase Home Finance LLC (the "Subservicer"), and in its name, aforesaid Attorney-In-Fact, by and through any of officer appointed by the Servicer or Subservicer, to execute and acknowledge in writing or by facsimile stamp all documents customarily and reasonably necessary and appropriate for the tasks described in the items (1) through (4) below; provided however, that the documents described below may only be executed and delivered by such Attorneys-In-Fact if such documents are required or permitted under the terms of the Servicing Agreement dated as of October 1, 2006, among Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc., as Seller, JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association, as Servicer or Chase Home Finance LLC, as Subservicer, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. as Master Servicer, and U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee to **Structured Asset Securities Corporation, Mortgage Pass-Through Certificates, Series 2006-BC3** and no power is granted hereunder to take any action that would be adverse to the interests of U.S. Bank National Association. This Limited Power of Attorney is being issued in connection with the Servicer's or Subservicer's responsibilities to service certain mortgage loans (the "Loans") held by U.S. Bank National Association in its capacity as Trustee. 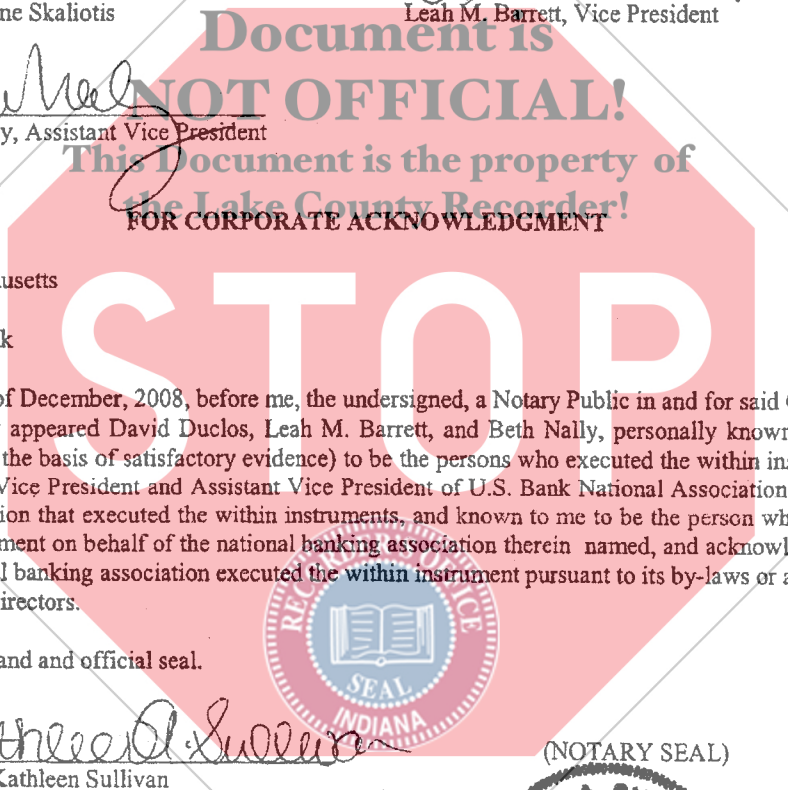
