THIS BOND IS EFFECTIVE the 24th day of July, 2010

LIABILITY UNDER THIS BOND SHALL terminate as of the 24th day of July, 2011 as to any acts subsequent thereto, unless said bond is continued in force from year to year by the issuance of a continuation certificate issued by the Surety. The aggregate liability of the Surety shall in no event exceed the amount of this bond regardless of the number of claims against the bond or the number of years the bond remains in force.

PROVIDED, THE LIABILITY OF THE SURETY may be terminated at any time by filing with the Obligee ten (10) days written notice of its desire to be relieved of liability. The Surety shall not be discharged from any liability already incurred under this bond, or which shall accrue hereunder before the expiration of the ten day period.

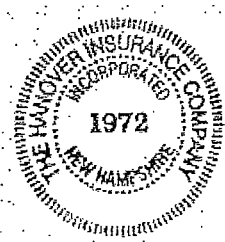
