As we commence work on your home, I would like to take a moment of your time to explain how Indiana Mechanics lien law works.

When we begin construction on your home, the "Notice to Owners" is required by law in order for subcontractors, like Meyer's to legally vest our interest. This procedure allows us to file a Mechanical Lien on the property we are working on in the event that we are not paid. **THIS IS NOT A LIEN.** It is nothing more than a Notice that if we are not paid, we reserve the right to file a lien.


