## ORDINANCE NO. 2011-10

## ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE STATION GRANTING A SPECIAL USE FOR 1122 MARQUETTE ROAD, LAKE STATION, INDIANA

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-4-918.6, the Common Council of the City of Lake Station, Indiana, has authority to grant petitions for a Special Use; and

WHEREAS. on June 22, 2011, the Board of Zoning appeals for the City of Lake Station approved the Petition for Special Use, "To buy and sell a limited number of motorized vehicles on the real estate located at 1122 Marquette Road, Lake Station, Indiana, currently zoned L-1", with a favorable recommendation and findings pursuant to I.C. 36-7-4-918.4, as follows:

> (1)the approval will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community; (2)the use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variance will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner;

> > the need for the variance arises from some condition peculiar to the property involved; 18 the strict application of the terms of the zoning ordinance will constitute an unnecessary hardship if applied to the property for which the variance is sought; and

the approval does not interfere substantially with the (5) comprehensive plan adopted under the 400 series of this chapter; and

WHEREAS,

the Petitioner/Owner, TERRY JOY agree to the following commitment which shall become part of the approval:

- The special use can be used for the sale of only two motorized vehicles at a time. Motorized vehicles for sale must be motorized vehicles with liens held by the Petitioner for work performed on the motorized vehicles.
- (2)The special use will terminate with sale or lease of the premises or business.
- The Petitioner shall be responsible for the City's Attorney (3) fees to enforce the commitments.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Lake Station Common Council adopts the findings of the 1.

  - a. The special use can be used for the sale of only two motorized vehicles at a time. Motorized vehicles for sale must be motorized vehicles with liens held by the Petitioner for work performed on the motorized vehicles.
  - b. The special use will terminate with sale or lease of the premises or business.
  - The Petitioner shall be responsible for the City's Attorney c. fees to enforce the commitments.
