License and Permit Bond for electrical work

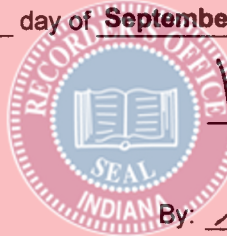
for a term beginning 11/14/2012 and ending 11/14/2013

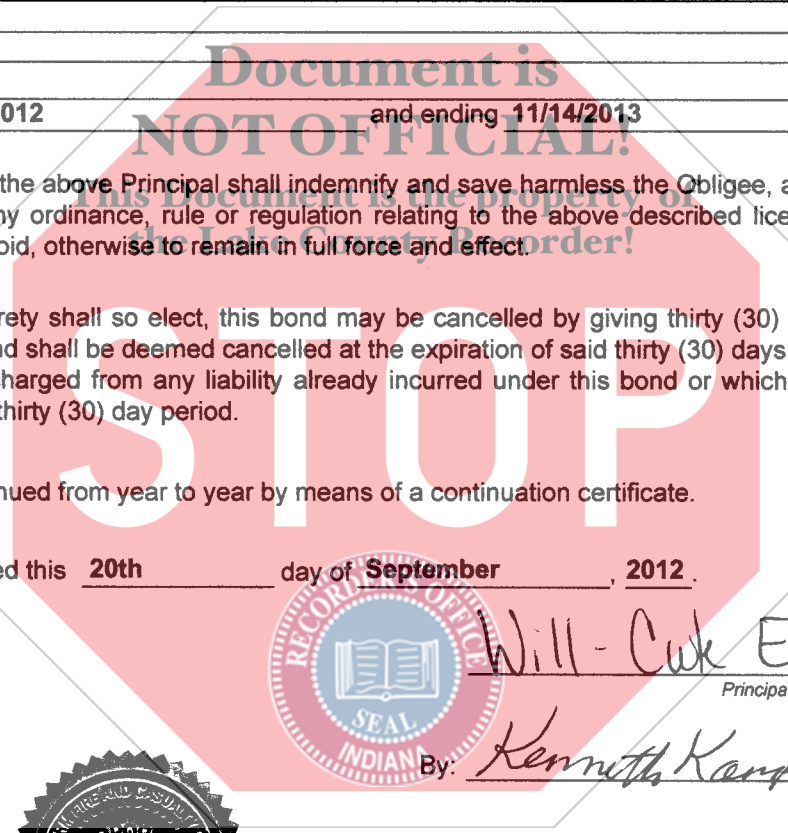

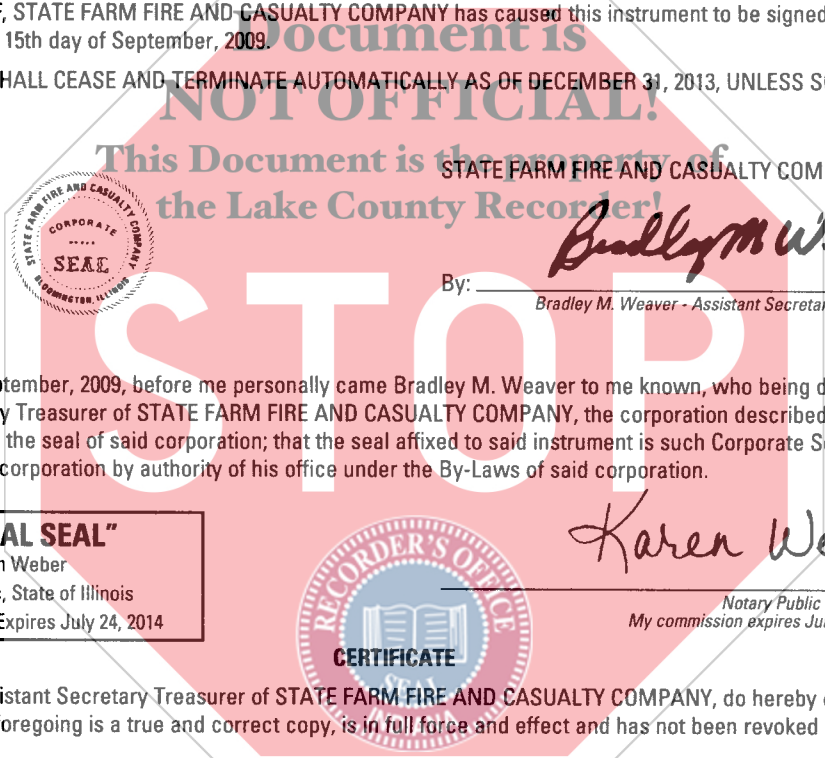
