POWER OF ATTORNEY

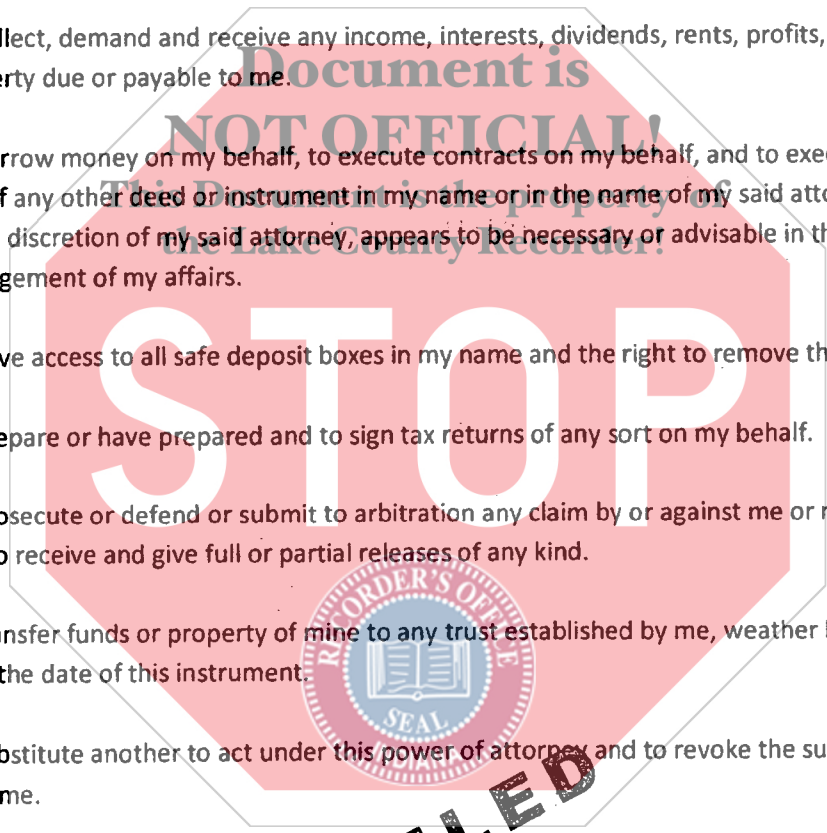
I, Lieutenant Colonel William G. White, presently stationed in Honolulu, Hawaii appoint my mother Dolores M White, to conduct all my affairs, with full power and authority to act in my name and on my behalf as fully as I could do if personally present. Without limiting the generality of his powers specifically authorize her to do the following:

1. To manage and have the general control and supervision of all my property and interests in property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, including power to buy, sell, lease, and mortgage.
2. To maintain bank accounts for me in my name, or in the name of my said attorney, and to make deposits or withdrawals of money belonging to me in such accounts, and to disburse any money from such accounts on the signature of my said attorney.
3. To pay all my bills and to expend funds for any purposes which my said attorney deems my benefit.
4. To collect, demand and receive any income, interests, dividends, rents, profits, or other property due or payable to me.
5. To borrow money on my behalf, to execute contracts on my behalf, and to execute on my behalf any other deed or instrument in my name or in the name of my said attorney, which in the discretion of my said attorney, appears to be necessary or advisable in the management of my affairs.
6. To have access to all safe deposit boxes in my name and the right to remove their contents.
7. To prepare or have prepared and to sign tax returns of any sort on my behalf.
8. To prosecute or defend or submit to arbitration any claim by or against me or my property and to receive and give full or partial releases of any kind.
9. To transfer funds or property of mine to any trust established by me, weather before or after the date of this instrument.
10. To substitute another to act under this power of attorney and to revoke the substitution at any time.
11. To do any of the foregoing in the United States of America.

I intend that this power of attorney shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incapacity.

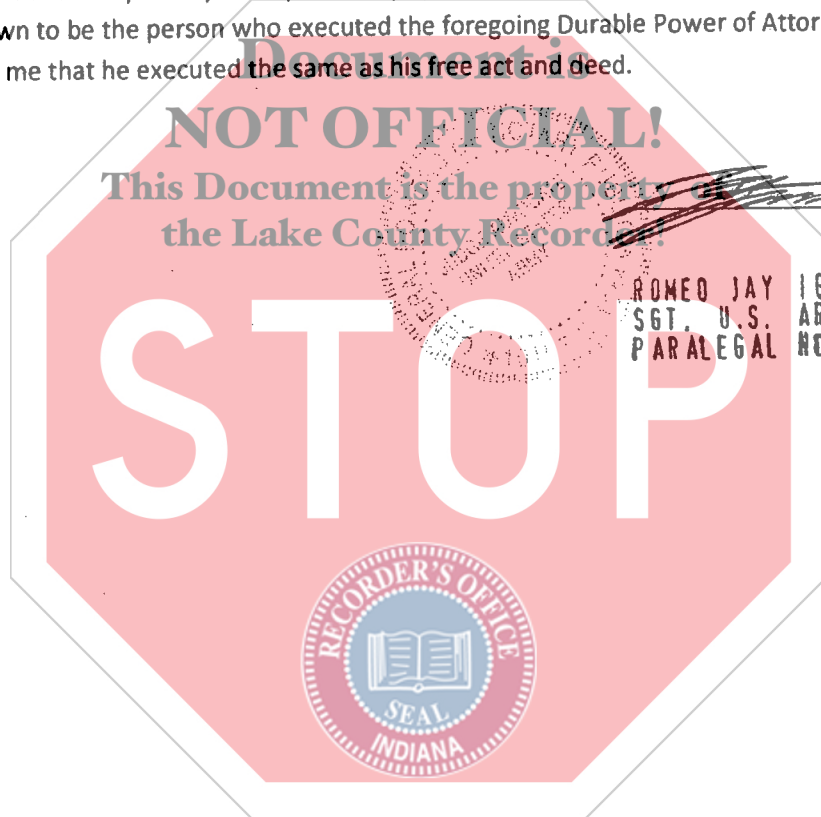
