ORDER

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Date Roods. The defendant, Edwardo Trevino Sr., appears in person with Attorney dam Tavitas. Further proceedings held. The State of Indiana files Amended Information adding Count III, Operating While Intoxicated Endangering a Person, a Class A Misdemeanor in Cause No. 45G02-1310-CM-00010. Parties submit a plea agreement in which the defendant enters a plea of guilty under oath to Count III, Operating While Intoxicated Endangering a Person, a Class A Misdemeanor in Cause No. 45G02-1310-CM-00010. The Court examines the defendant further under oath and finds that he understands the nature of the charges against him; and the possible penalties; that his plea of guilty is voluntarily and knowingly entered; and that there is a factual basis for the plea. The Court accepts the plea agreement on this date and now enters judgment of conviction for the offense of Count III, Operating While Intoxicated Endangering a Person, a Class A Misdemeanor in Cause No. 45G02-1310-CM-00010.

The parties waive the preparation of the presentence investigation report for purposes of sentencing.

## SENTENCING STATEMENT:

The Court now enters the following findings and sentence:

## **FINDINGS:**

After presentation of evidence and hearing argument, the Court finds that the agreed term as stipulated to by the parties is a reasonable and appropriate sentence based on the law and facts of the case.

## **SENTENCE:**

Pursuant to the terms of the plea agreement, the Court now sentences the defendant as follows:

MC SSE The defendant is now ordered committed to the custody of the Lake County Jail for a period of one (1) year.

The sentence of imprisonment is suspended.

The defendant is placed on probation for one (1) year under the terms and conditions of the court's probation agreement. The court imposes probation fees as determined and assessed by the Probation Department. Additional conditions of probation are as follows:

- 1. Enroll in and complete an alcohol program;
- 2. Pay a counter measure fee of two hundred (\$200.00);
- 3. Driver's license shall be suspended for ninety (90) days;
- 4. Conviction is to be reported to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles.

The defendant is to receive credit for 93 days spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus 93 days of good time credit as provided by law for a total of 186 days credit toward the sentence of imprisonment.

The defendant shall pay a court costs fee which the Court orders reduced to a judgment against the defendant. ent is

The defendant has been advised of his postconviction relief rights and appeal rights.

The defendant is remanded to the supervision of the Probation Department for execution of the judgment of the court. ecorder!

The defendant is ordered released from custody INSTANTER, subject to any outstanding holds or warrants.

Pursuant to the terms of the plea agreement, the State of Indiana files a motion to dismiss Counts I and II in Cause No. 45G02-1310-CM-00010 and Cause No. 45G02-1309-FC-00104, which is granted. The clerk is directed to notify the Lake County Sheirff. Cause is disposed. (Erika L. Kelliher reporting)
