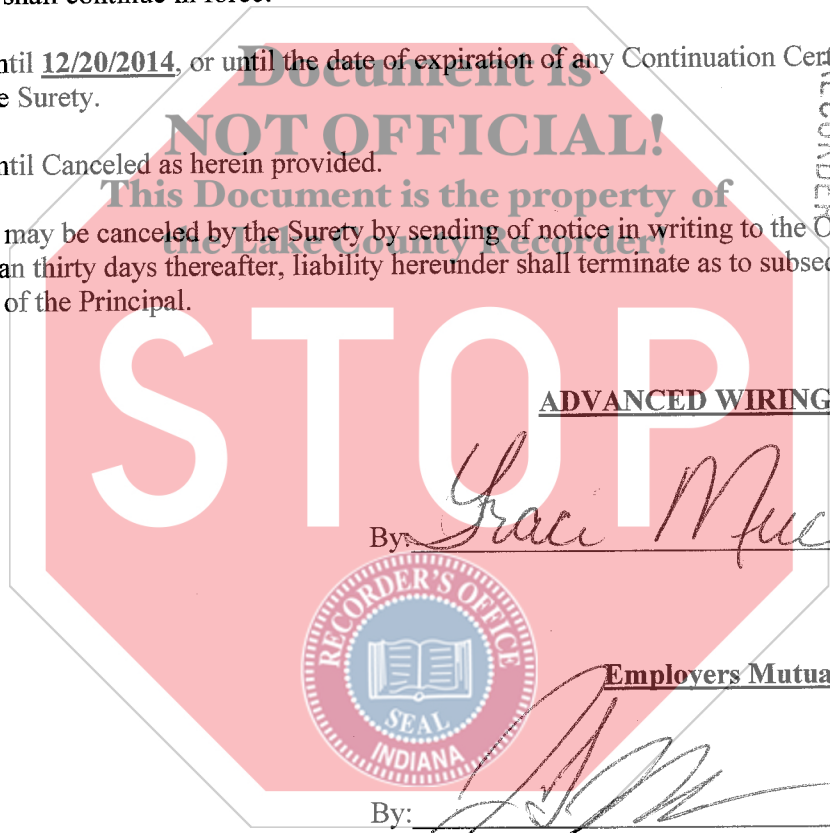

The authority hereby granted shall expire APRIL 1, 2016 unless sooner revoked.

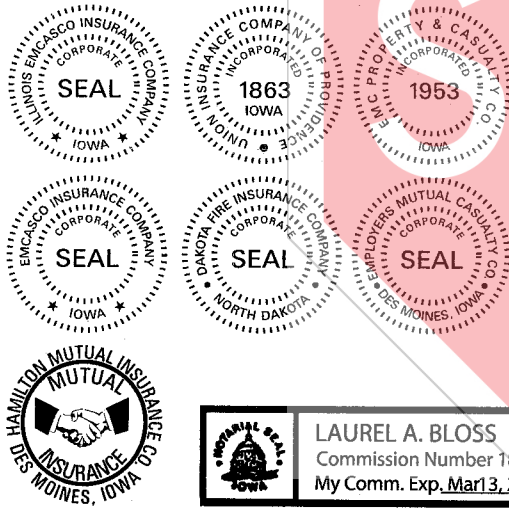
AUTHORITY FOR POWER OF ATTORNEY
