Be advised inspections of the above referenced property on August 15 2013, September 11, 2012, and March 22, 2011, by the Lake County Unsafe Buildings Department showed it to be in an unsafe state according to Unsafe Buildings Ordinance #1012, as amended (Ordinance). The Ordinance incorporates all provisions of Indiana Code 36-7-9 et al, entitled Unsafe Building Law, including the negative impact that unsafe structures have on the health and safety of the public, I.C. 36-7-9-4.5.

We have attempted to contact you at least two different times by written Letters of the Unsafe Buildings Department's Enforcement Authority on May 5, 2011 and again on April 8, 2013. To date, nothing has been done to correct the unsafe situation contained on your premises.




vacant and not maintained in a manner that would not allow human habitation, occupancy or use under the requirements of a statute or an ordinance

Among the items identified during our inspection that classifies this property as an unsafe premises are:

The structures have deteriorated beyond a point that it appears they are salvageable and are open and pose a hazard to the public. There is a great deal of debris spread about the property. The structure appears to have had a catastrophic fire that has reduced the building to ash and debris.

Because of the hazard this property poses to the safety of the public, let this letter serve as an notice issued by the Unsafe Buildings Department that the following action(s) shall be taken;



As used in the preceding list of options, *immediate*, means within twenty-one (21) days of the date that this order was issued.

In the event you choose to comply with this Order, please check with the Lake County Planning and Building Department to determine whether a Building and Zoning Permit is required prior to beginning any work. They may be reached at 219-755-3700. Due to the fact that we have granted you twenty-one (21) days to complete all work related to this Order, if you choose to comply, you must show a substantial beginning toward completion of this Order within ten (10) days of the date this Order was issued. If a Building and Zoning Permit is required, it may take up to five (5) working days to be issued after a proper and complete application is submitted. A substantial beginning means at least fifty (50) percent of the total work involved is completed. Since we have made attempts to contact you previously, we will schedule public hearing with the Unsafe Buildings Hearing Authority (Board) in order to obtain the necessary Order to return the property to a safe condition.

You have the right to appeal the findings of this Order with the Unsafe Buildings Hearing Authority (Board) at a public hearing to be held Friday, November 15, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Lake County Commissioners Courtroom/Council Chambers on the third (3rd) floor of Building "A", Lake County Government Center, 2293 North Main Street, Crown Point, Indiana. This will be an advertised public hearing at which time you will have the opportunity to appear, present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, present arguments and state your case to the Board. This is the only notice that you will receive regarding your hearing. Any additional notice will be provided as directed by the Ordinance. Be advised that the Unsafe Buildings Department will be seeking an Order from the Unsafe Buildings Hearing Authority to proceed as indicated above on your property or the property indicated herein where you have a substantial property interest.

At the conclusion of your hearing, the Hearing Authority may make findings and take action to affirm the Order issued by the Unsafe Buildings Department, rescind the Order issued by the Unsafe Buildings Department or modify the Order issued by the Unsafe Buildings Department. If the person or persons to whom the Order was issued are not present at the hearing, the Board may modify the Order in only a manner that makes the terms less stringent.

Please notify us of your intention to appear before the Board to dispute our findings at least ten (10) working days prior to your above scheduled hearing.

If you choose to ignore the Order and your scheduled opportunity to appear before the Unsafe Buildings Hearing Authority, the Board shall take whatever action necessary to ensure the unsafe buildings or structures located on your unsafe premises are made to comply with the Ordinance. Further, if the Board finds that there is a willful failure to comply with the Order, in addition to affirming the Order, the Board may impose a civil penalty in addition to other penalties imposed under the Ordinance and State Law.
