

Extreme weather conditions (large snow packs and deep frost) made monument recovery particularly difficult. An iron rod with Torrenga Cap was found at the Northwest corner of Lot 1 and iron pipes were found along the

on the North line of Shady Oak 2nd Addition as shown on the plat. These monuments were found and used by the Bock and Clark Survey. The monuments found were in good condition. THEORY OF LOCATION:

A traverse was run between the found monumentation, building corners and fences. The survey was rotated to match the bearings shown on the recorded plat of Bakker Produce. The resultant distances matched within tolerance of the Bakker Produce Subdivision Plat and the Bock & Clark Alta Survey. DESCRIPTIONS:

Based on the survey traverse, the location of a fence dividing the industrial side of the parcel from the residential property and retention pond was plotted. A line was established roughly 1 foot Westerly of the existing


A Legal Description was developed based on the line to create a parcel to Add to Lot 2 and Deduct from Lot 1. The reult of the decriptions should be to facilitate creating two Tax parcel numbers.

POSSESSION LINES: There is fencing along the perimeter of the parcels which may encroach off of the property as indicated on the Bock & Clark Survey. The purpose of this survey was to address the legal Descriptions around Lot 2. No attemp was made to verify the remaining boundary which was just surveyed by Bock & Clark. Due to the Extreme Weather conditions, no monuments were set at the new corners of the description at this time. The relative Posional Accuracy "RPA" due to random errors in measurements) of this survey is within that allowable for an Suburban Survey (0.13 'plus 100 ppm) as defined IAC, Title 865 ("Relative Positional Accuracy" means the value expressed in feet or meters that represents the uncwertainty due to random errors in measurements in the location of any point on a survey relative to any other point on the same survey at the 95 percent confidence
