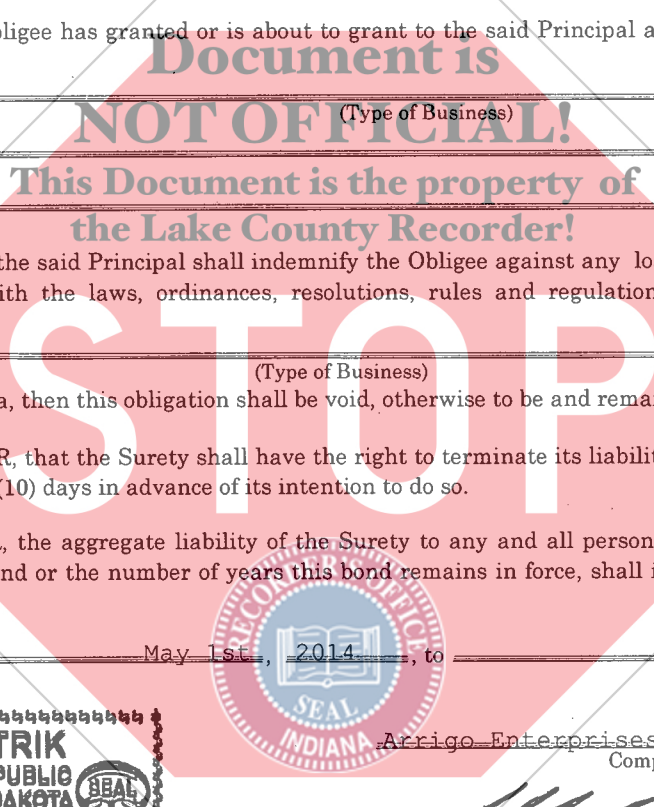
KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Arrigo Enterprises, Inc.
