

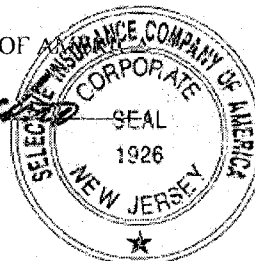

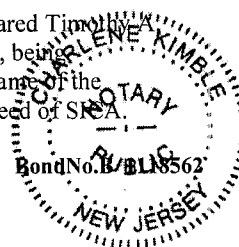

POLICYHOLDER DISCLOSURE NOTICE OF TERRORISM INSURANCE COVERAGE

The Terrorism Risk Insurance Act of 2002 establishes a program within the Department of the Treasury under which the federal government shares, with the insurance industry, the risk of loss from future terrorist attacks.
