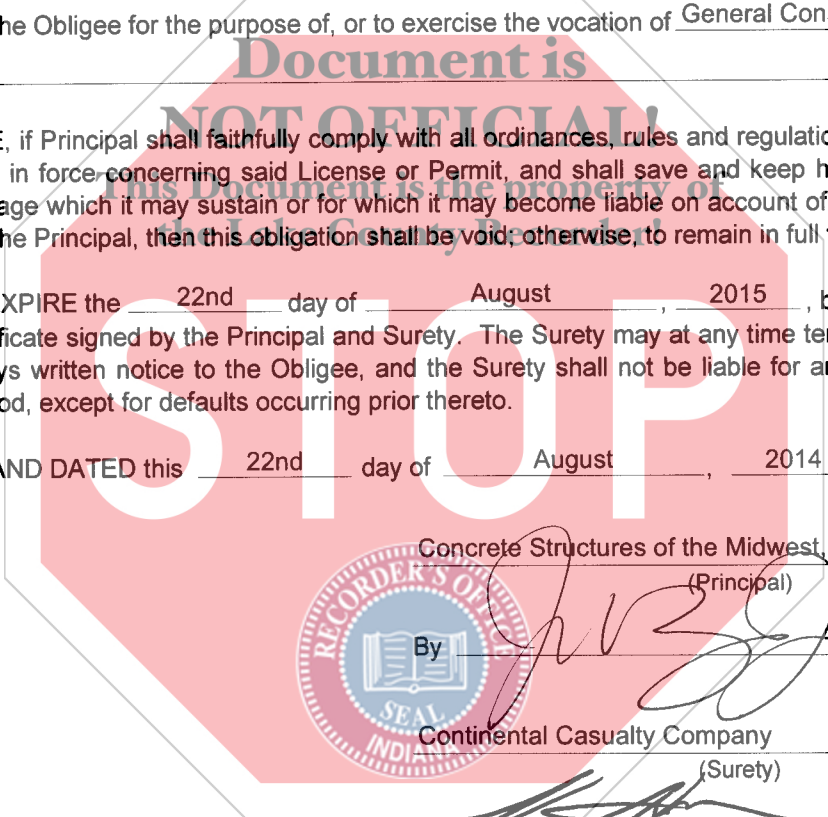
KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Concrete Structures of the Midwest, Inc. of

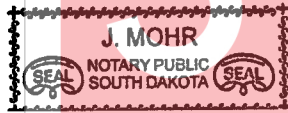
