COUNT I

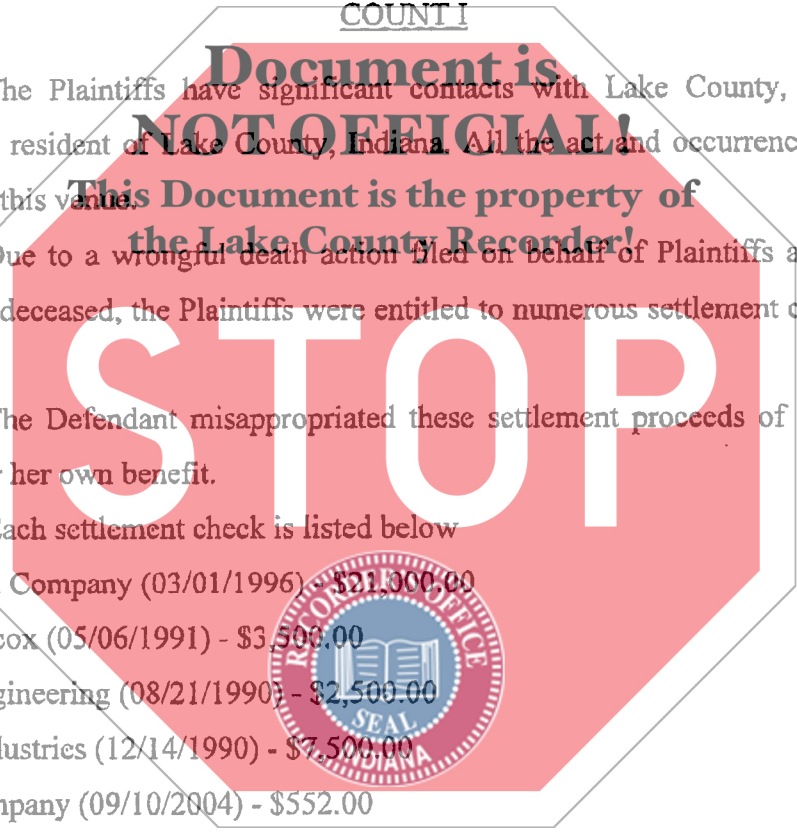

- Unarco (10/21/1997) - \$1,424.00



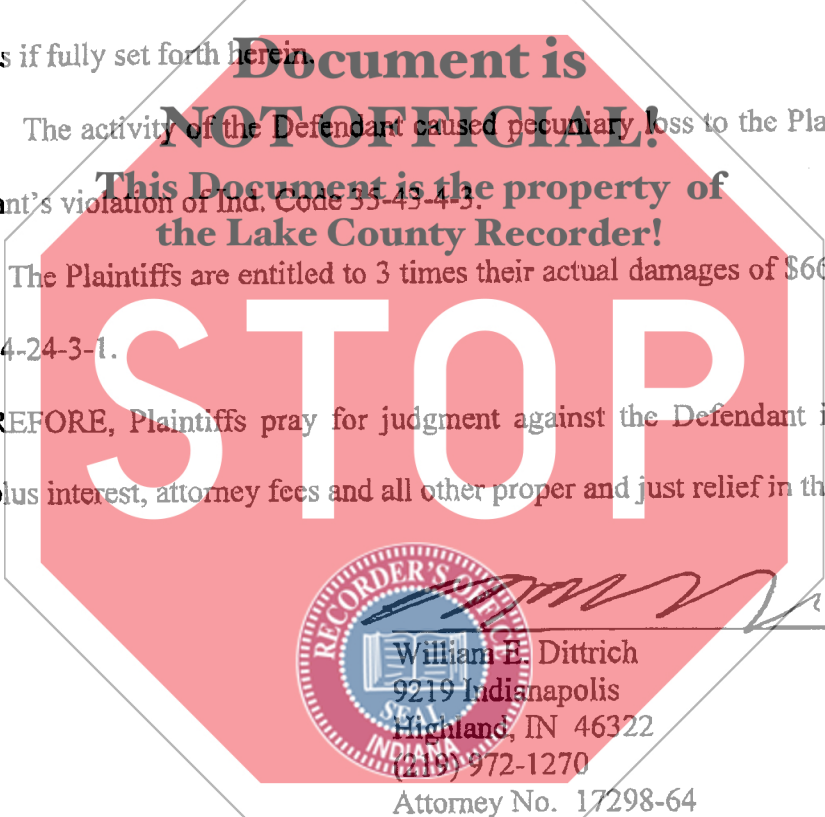
COUNT II
