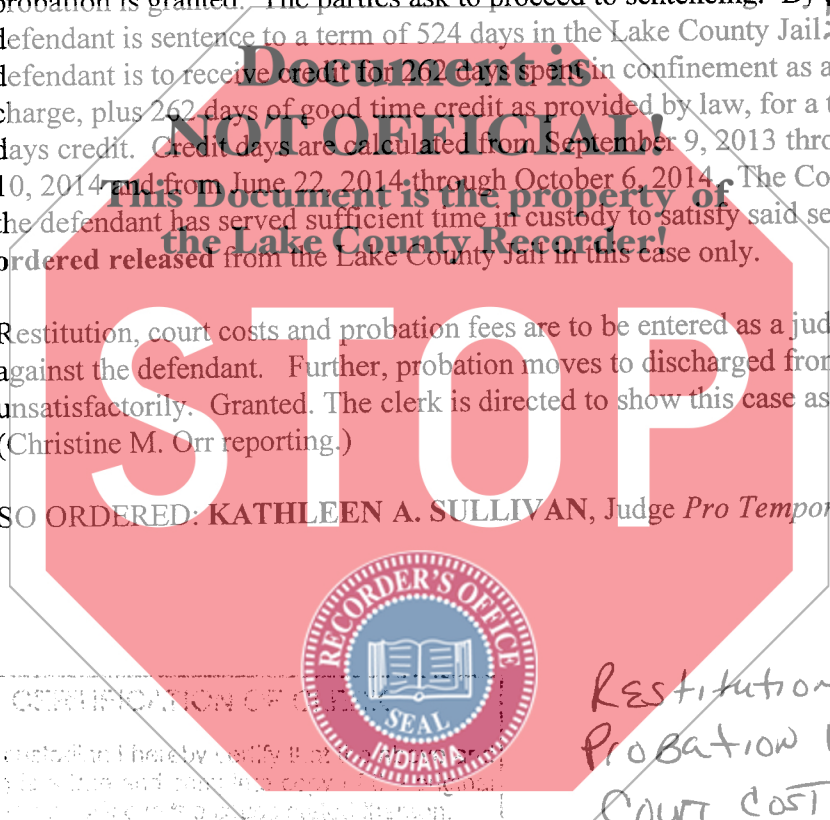
ORDER

10-07-14

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Thomas S. Mullins. The defendant appears in person with Attorney John Cantrell. The Probation Department appears by Probation Officer Erin Stokes. The defendant waives the advisement of rights. The defendant admits the allegations contained in the petition to revoke probation as to Rules 5, 7, 11 and 12 only. Petition to revoke probation is granted. The parties ask to proceed to sentencing. By agreement, the defendant is sentenced to a term of 524 days in the Lake County Jail. The defendant is to receive credit for 262 days spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus 262 days of good time credit as provided by law, for a total of 524 days credit. Credit days are calculated from September 9, 2013 through February 10, 2014 and from June 22, 2014 through October 6, 2014. The Court finds that the defendant has served sufficient time in custody to satisfy said sentence and is ordered released from the Lake County Jail in this case only.

Restitution, court costs and probation fees are to be entered as a judgment lien against the defendant. Further, probation moves to discharged from probation unsatisfactorily. Granted. The clerk is directed to show this case as disposed. (Christine M. Orr reporting.)
