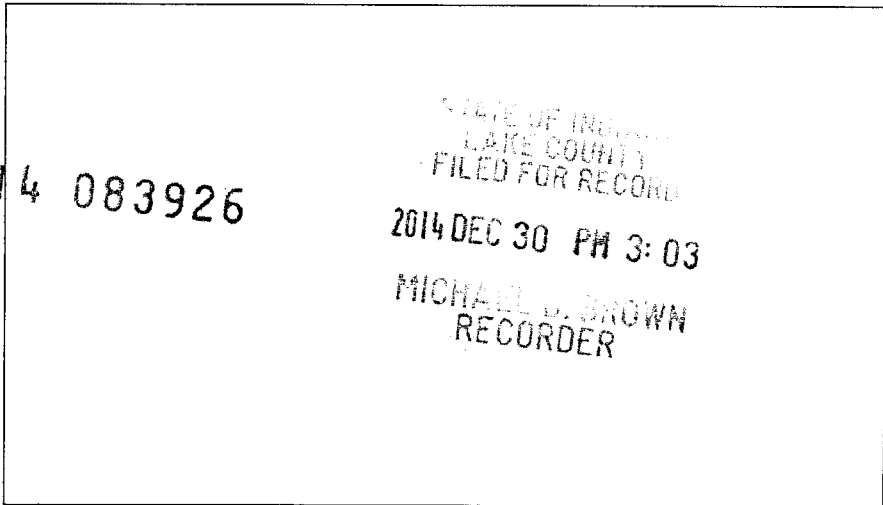

NOTICE is hereby given of a lien against the property and rights to property, both real and personal, of the defendant named below. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3613,

a fine or restitution imposed in a case brought under Title 18 of the United States Code is a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, both real and or personal, belonging to the defendant. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3613(c), a notice of lien shall be considered a notice of lien for taxes for the purposes of any State or local law providing for the filing of a tax lien. The lien arises on the entry of judgment and continues until the liability is satisfied, remitted, or set aside, or until it becomes unenforceable.

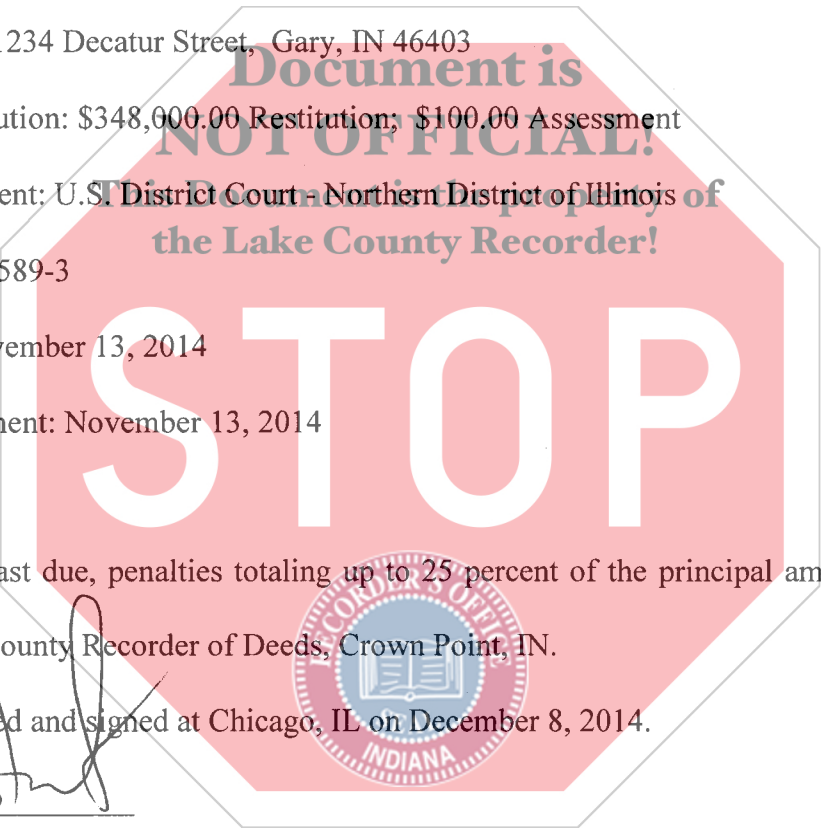
