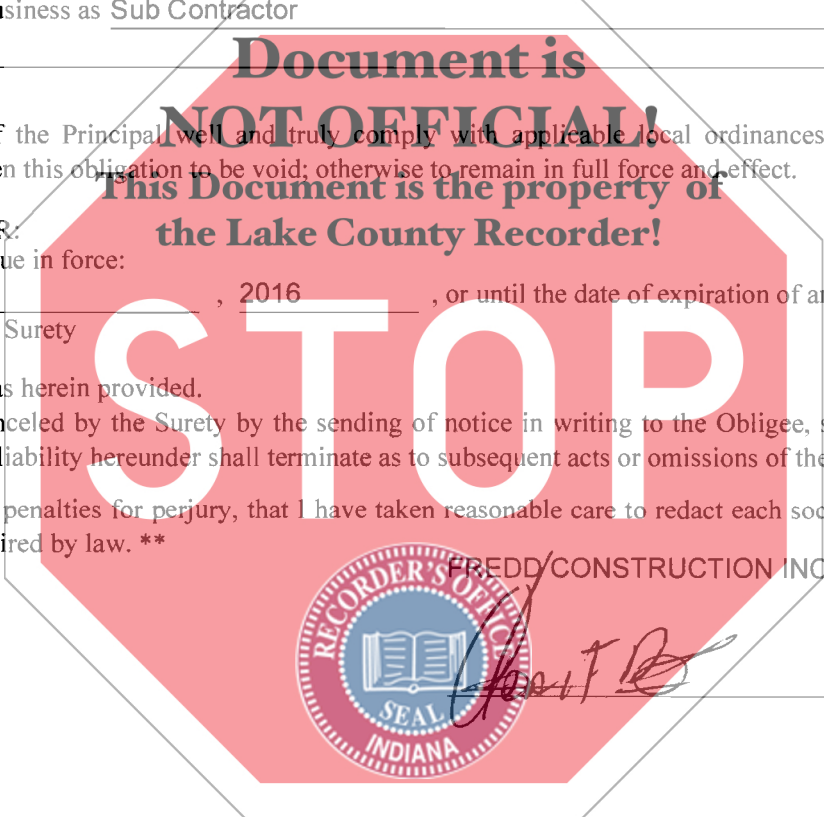
PROVIDED, HOWEVER:
