The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Alexander Dimitrijevic. The defendant, Latia K. Hinkle, appears in person and by Attorney Joseph Svetanoff. Formal appearance is held in Cause No. 45G02-1409-F6-00019. Further proceedings held. The parties submit a plea agreement in which the defendant enters pleas of guilty under oath to Count I, Fraud, a Level 6 Felony in Cause No. 45G02-1409-F6-00031; and Count I, Fraud, a Level 6 Felony in Cause No. 45G02-1501-F6-00019. The Court examines the defendant further under oath and finds that she understands the nature of the charges against her and the possible penalties; her pleas of guilty are voluntarily and knowingly entered; and there is a factual basis for the pleas. The Court accepts the plea agreement on this date and now enters judgment of conviction for the offenses of Count I, Fraud, a Level 6 Felony in Cause No. 45G02-1409-F6-00031; and Count I, Fraud, a Level 6 Felony in Cause No. 45G02-1501-F6-00019.

The parties waive the preparation of the presentence investigation report for purposes of sentencing.

SENTENCING STATEMENT:

The Court now enters the following findings and sentence:

FINDINGS:

After presentation of evidence and hearing argument, the Court finds that the agreed term as stipulated to by the parties is a reasonable and appropriate sentence based on the law and facts of the case.

SENTENCE:

Pursuant to the terms of the plea agreement, the Court now sentences the defendant as follows:

N/c
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The defendant is now ordered committed to the custody of the Department of Correction for a period of two (2) years on Count I in Cause No. 45G02-1409-F6-00031; and two (2) years on Count I in Cause No. 45G02-1501-F6-00019.

The sentences of imprisonment are to be served consecutively.

The sentences of imprisonment are suspended.

The defendant is placed on probation for a period of four (4) years under the terms and conditions of the court probation agreement. The Court imposes probation fees as determined and assessed by the Probation Department. Additional conditions of probation are as follows:

1. Obtain/maintain gainful employment.

The defendant was incarcerated from June 14, 2016 to June 20, 2016 (or 6 days). The defendant is entitled to jail time credit and good time credit as provided by law to this date. The Court has not included today's date for the reason that the facility to which the defendant is sentenced is to consider today's date as the first date of the defendant's sentence.

The defendant shall pay a court costs fee in both causes which the Court orders reduced to a judgment against the defendant.


The defendant has been advised of her postconviction relief and appeal rights.

The defendant is remanded to the supervision of the Probation Department for execution of the judgment of the court.

The defendant is ordered released from custody INSTANTER, subject to any outstanding holds or warrants.

Pursuant to the terms of the plea agreement, the State of Indiana files a motion to dismiss Count II in Cause No. 45G02-1409-F6-00031; and Count II in Cause No. 45G02-1501-F6-00019, which is granted. The clerk is directed to notify the Sheriff of Lake County, and to prepare an electronic abstract of judgment. Causes are disposed. (Marianna Runkle reporting.)
