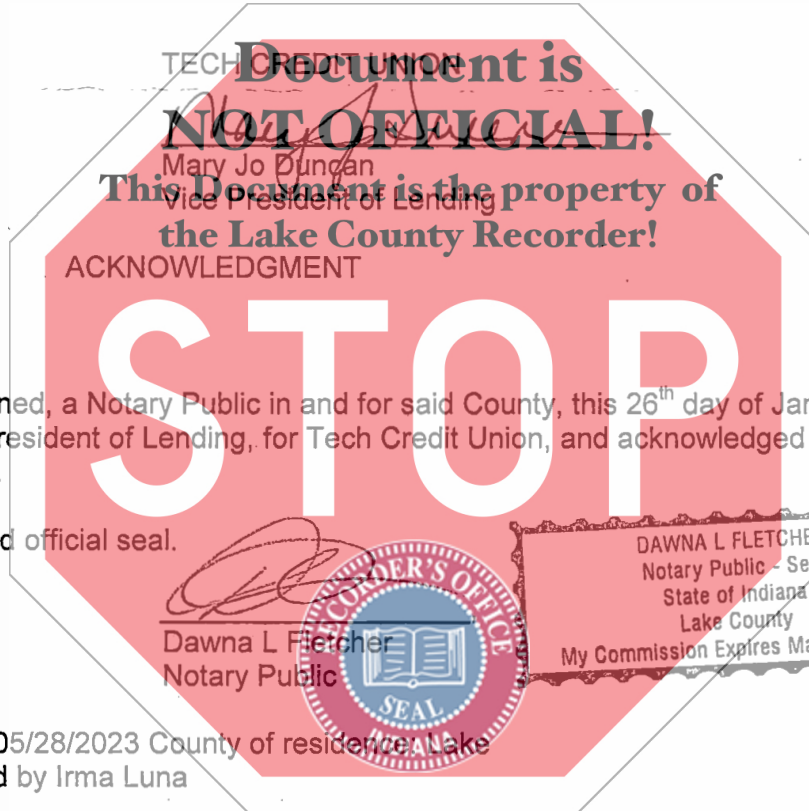

Parcel 1: A part of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 22, Township 34 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the point of intersection of the center line of the right of way of the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railroad with the center line of the Cedar Lake Road or Highway (which said point of intersection is 651 feet Northerly of the intersection of the South line of said Section with the centerline of said railroad), thence Easterly along the center of said Cedar Lake Road, 50 feet to the point of commencement of this description, thence Northerly along the East right of way line of said railroad, 123-1/2 feet, thence Easterly 113-1/2 feet, thence Southerly 107-1/2 feet to the center of said Cedar Lake Road, thence Westerly along the center of said Cedar Lake Road, 115-1/2 feet to the point of beginning. (The Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railroad right of way hereinabove referred to is such as it did exist on the 25th day of November, 1903), in Lake County, Indiana.

Parcel 2:

A part of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 22, Township 34 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian, described as: Commencing at a point on the Easterly right of way line of the Chicago Indianapolis and Louisville Railroad at the Northwest corner of the tract above described, thence Northwesterly along said East right of way line 100 feet, thence North 67 degrees 05 minutes East 130 feet, thence South 18 degrees 54 minutes East 207-1/2 feet, more or less to the center of Cedar Lake Road, thence Westerly in the center of said road 16-1/2 feet to the Southeast corner of the tract above described, thence North 18 degrees 54 minutes West 107-1/2 feet to the Northeast corner of said lot as described in Parcel 1 above, thence South 67 degrees 05 minutes West 113-1/2 feet to the point of beginning, in Lake County, Indiana.

RR., 223.50 feet, thence South 67 degrees 05 minutes West 50 feet to the centerline of said railroad, thence Southeasterly along the center line of said abandoned railroad 236.05 feet, to the center line of said Lake Shore Drive (or Cedar Lake Road), thence Northeasterly 50 feet, more or less to the point of beginning, in Lake County, Indiana.
