
By the following instrument the chairman or the president has authorized the officer or other official named therein to appoint attorneys-in-fact:

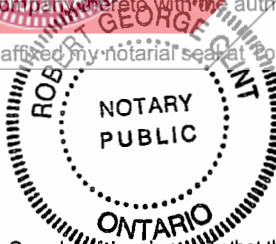


