The defendant, Alec R. Holmes, appears in person and by Attorney Roy Dominguez. That the pieceeous type of guilty under oath to Count I, Failure to Return to Lawful Detention, a Level 6 Felony in Cause No. 45G02-1706-F6-00135. The defendant also admits to violations as alleged in the petition to expel in Cause No. 45G02-1605-F5-00048. The Court examines the defendant further under oath and finds that he understands the nature of the charges against him and the possible penalties; his plea of guilty is voluntarily and knowingly entered; and there is a factual basis for the plea. The Court accepts the plea agreement on this date and now enters judgment of conviction for the offense of Count I, Failure to Return to Lawful Detention appears in person and by Attorney Roy

The parties waive the preparation of the presentence investigation report for purposes of sentencing.

SENTENCING STATEMEN

The Court now enters the following findings and sentence:

FINDINGS:

After presentation of evidence and hearing argument, the Court finds that the agreed term as stipulated to by the parties is a reasonable and appropriate sentence based on the law and facts of the case.

SENTENCE:

Pursuant to the terms of the plea agreement, the Court now sentences the defendant as follows:

NIC

In Cause No. 45G02-1706-F6-00135, the defendant is now ordered committed to the custody of the Lake County Jail for a period of three hundred thirty-eight (338) days.

In Cause No. 45G02-1605-F5-00048, the defendant is sentenced to three (3) years in the Indiana Department of Correction. Said sentence is to be served on ICU Court Monitoring Home Detention Program. The defendant is to be evaluated for and enroll in ICU Court Monitoring Wrap Around Services. By agreement of the parties, any costs associated with ICU Court Monitoring Services Home Detention or Wrap Around Services shall be at the expense of the defendant. The defendant may serve his Department of Correction sentence for not less than the earliest release date and not more than the maximum sentence.

The sentences of imprisonment are to be served consecutively.

In Cause No. 45G02-1706-F6-00135, the defendant was incarcerated from June 22, 2017 through December 8, 2017 (or 169 actual days). The defendant is entitled to jail time credit and good time credit as provided by law for the above dates.

The parties agree that defendant is time served in Cause No. 45G02-1706-F6-00135.

The defendant shall pay a court costs fee which the Court orders reduced to a judgment against the defendant.

The defendant has been advised of his postconviction relief rights and appeal rights.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of the Sheriff of Lake County for execution of the judgment of the court.

The clerk is directed to prepare an electronic abstract of judgment and to notify the Sheriff of Lake County and ICU Court Monitoring. Causes are disposed. (Marianna Runkle reporting.)
