ORDER

The defendant, Nicole Michelle Proctor, appears in person with Attorney Lemuel Stigler. The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Mark Watson. The defendant admits the allegations contained in the Petition to Eschel from the Therapeutic Intervention Court. The petition is granted. The Court accepts the plea of guilty tendered on July 24, 2018 and enters judgment on the crime of Count II: Resisting Law enforcement, Level 6 felony. The defendant is sentenced to eighteen (18) months in the Department of Correction. The defendant is to receive credit for 361 days spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus 361 days of good time credit as provided by law, for a total of 722 days credit. The Court finds that the defendant has served sufficient time in custody to satisfy the executed portion of said sentence and is **ordered released** from the Lake County Jail in this case only.

As an additional condition of this sentence, the defendant was ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$300.00 to the victim, Highland Police Department. The restitution is to be entered as a judgment against the defendant and for Highland Police Department is the judgment docket of the Clerk of this Court

The State of Indiana, by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Mark Watson, files motion to dismiss Counts I and III through X, which is granted. Public Defender fees are waived. Court costs are assessed. Defendant is found to be indigent and shall not be incarcerated for failure to pay court costs. Case disposed. [Nanetta L. Stigler reporting.]
