The defendant, Nicole Michelle Proctor, appears in person with Attorney Lemuel

Watson. The defendant admits the allegations contained in the Petition to Expel
from the Therapeutic Intervention Court. The petition is granted. The Court
accepts the plea of guilty tendered on July 24, 2018 and enters judgment for the
