performing all the ordinances of the said Obligee, and faithfully observing and complying with all rules and
regulations of all department of said Obliges governing or regulating said contracting work and shall also indemnify,
save and keep harmless the said Obligee for any loss, cost and damages, expense or liability of any kind whatsoever,

herein shall in no event exceed the penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

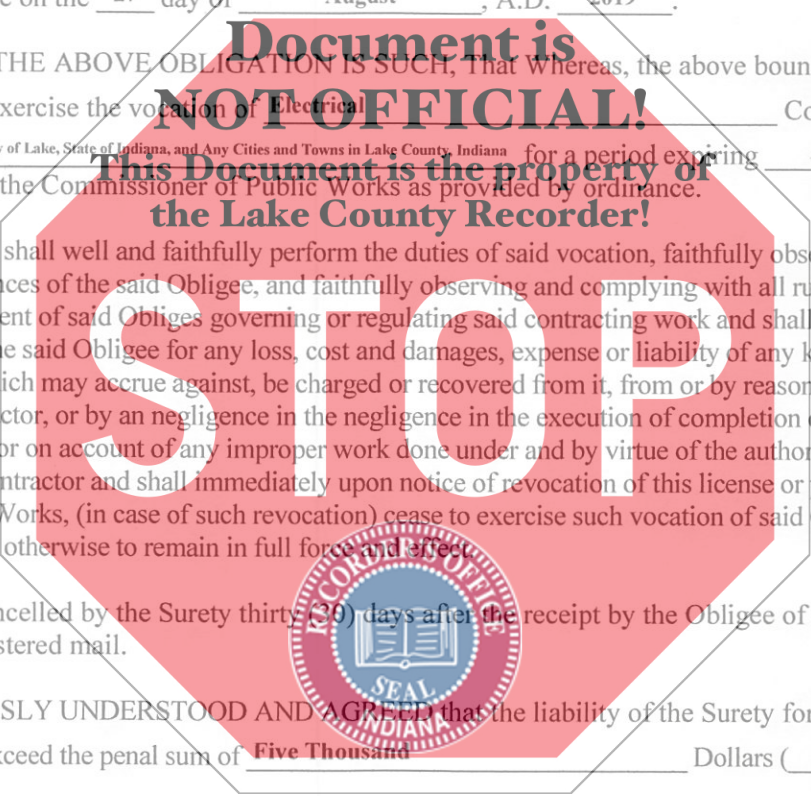
THE LIABILITY UNDER THIS BOND TERMINATES on the 27 day of August, 2020, and
