The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Veronica Gonzalez The defendant appears in person, and in custody, with Deputy Public Defender Lemuel Stigler. Kristen K. Stokes reporting. The parties file a Stipulated Plea and Agreement whereby the defendant tenders a plea of guilty to Count I, Identity Deception, as a level 6 Felony. The Court reviews all of the terms of the Plea Agreement with the defendant who acknowledges understanding of same. A factual basis is established for the plea, and the Court finds the defendant's plea of guilty to be knowing and voluntarily made. Judgment of conviction is entered on Count I, Identity Deception, as a Level 6 Felony. The parties waive the presentence investigation report and wish to proceed to sentencing today. According to the agreed term in the plea agreement, the defendant is sentenced to six (6) months in the Lake County Jail. The defendant is to receive credit for three (3) months spent in confinement as a result of this charge, plus three (3) months of good time credit as provided by law for a total of six (6) months credit toward the sentence of imprisonment. The Court finds that the defendant has served the executed portion of his sentence and orders the defendant released on this charge only. The defendant is ordered to pay a court costs fee which the Court orders reduced to judgment against the defendant.
