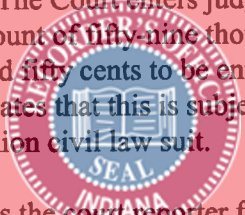

The State of Indiana appears by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Reginald Marcus and Veronica Gonzalez. The defendant appears in person with Attorney Edward Hearn. Yvette M. Gaskill reporting. Parties appear for sentencing. Neither the State or the defendant has any additions, corrections, or deletions to the presentence investigation report. The defendant adopts same under oath as being true and accurate. Having considered the written presentence investigation report, the contents of which the Court incorporates by reference, as well as I.C. 35-38-1-1.3 and I. C. 35-38-1-7.1, and after having hearing evidence and arguments of counsel, and judgment previously having been entered as Criminal Conversion, a Class A Misdemeanor. The Court sentences the defendant to one (1) year Lake County Jail. Said sentence suspended to be served on probation, to commence at time of sentencing. Standard probation fees apply. The defendant is to receive jail time credit for June 19, 2017 as a result of this charge plus good time credit as provided by law.

Court cost are waived. The Court enters judgment against the defendant in favor of the victim in the amount of fifty-nine thousand, four-hundred sixty-two (\$59,462.50) dollars and fifty cents to be entered with the Lake County Recorder's Office. The Court indicates that this is subject to modification pending the outcome of the companion civil law suit.

Attorney Hearn requests the court reporter fee be paid as a result of him working pro bono on behalf of the defendant. The Court directs counsel to file a Petition for Public Defender Funds. The defendant is remanded to the supervision of the Probation Department for execution fo the judgment of the Court. Cause disposed.
