- 4. As a result of the death of the decedent, title to the subject real estate has devolved to the following distributees in the proportion and in the manner shown adjacent to their name, as the only four children of the decedent who survived the decedent:

A. GLORIA DITTRICH, 25% intestate transfer as a tenant in common.

B. WALTER MATTHEW DITTRICH, 25% intestate transfer as a tenant in common.

C. WANDA WOZNIAK, 25% intestate transfer as a tenant in common.

D. MARK DITTRICH, 25% intestate transfer as a tenant in common.
