ABOVE STATED HEARING WAS HELD AND THE CITY OF HOBART UNSAFE BUILDING HEARING AUTHORITY AFFIRMS THE ORDER OF THE UNSAFE BUILDINGS DEPARTMENT AND NOW FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THE DULY ADOPTED City of Hobart Municipal Code Unsafe Buildings § 150.110 et. seq. (Ordinance No. 1747), THE STRUCTURE AND IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING PREMISES LOCATED AT 229 N. OHIO STREET, HOBART, INDIANA 46342 AND STATED MORE ACCURATELY ABOVE AND ON THE ATTACHED DOCUMENTS IS IN AN UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS STATE, THEREFORE BY ORDER OF THE CITY OF HOBART UNSAFE BUILDINGS HEARINGS AUTHORITY THE STRUCTURES IN QUESTION SHALL BE DEMOLISHED AND ALL REMAINING DEBRIS SHALL BE REMOVED. NOTICE IS HEREBY given that a Public Hearing will be held by Unsafe Building Hearing Authority of the City of Hobart, the Hobart Public Works and Safety, on Wednesday, Tune 15, 2022 at 3:30 pm. in the Council Chambers on the second (2nd) floor of Hobart City Hall, 414 Main Street, Hobart, Indiana, 46342 to consider:

Pursuant to the provisions of the City of Hobart Municipal Code § 150.110 et. seq. an Order of the Hobart Building Department was issued on March 34, 2033. The City of Hobart Building Official has determined the residence located at 339.01. Ohio St. Hobart, Indiana 46342, with Parcel I.D. Numbers of 45.09.39.49.90.00.018, to be in an unsafe condition. Further, the Order of the Hobart Building Department, in part, has required potential removal of the unsafe building or associated structure(s) and debris and grading of the remaining property such that it does not pose a threat to the public.

A copy of the Hobart Municipal Code § 150.110 et. seq, (Ordinance 1747) and Order of the Unsafe Buildings Department are both on file in the Office of the Hobart Building Department, 414 Main Street, Hobart, Indiana 46342, and may be examined, along with other records pertaining to the property, in their entirety from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding approved holidays, prior to the Public Hearing.

Written objections will be considered at the Public Hearing and may be filed with the Hobart Building Department, 414 Main Street, Hobart, Indiana 46342. Such written objections shall be filed at least three (3) working days prior to the Public Hearing. Oral comments concerning the proposal will be heard at the Public Hearing at the date and time affixed above. The Public Hearing may be continued by the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety from time to time as may be found necessary. After hearing any and all parties having a substantial property interest and taking into account all information presented, the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety will render a decision on the Order of the City of Hobart Building Department.

Because of the hazard this property poses to the safety of the public, let this letter serve as an Order issued by the City of Hobart Building Department (Enforcement Authority) that the following action(s) shall be taken;

As used in the preceding list of options, *immediate*, means within thirty (30) days of the date that this order was issued.

In the event you choose to comply with this Order, please check with the City of Hobart Building Department to determine whether a Building Permit is required prior to beginning any work. They may be reached at 219-942-1722. Due to the fact that we have granted you thirty (30) days to complete all work related to this Order, if you choose to comply, you must show a substantial beginning toward completion of this Order within fifteen (15) days of the date this Order was issued. If a Building Permit is required, it may take up to ten (10) working days to be issued after a proper and complete application is submitted. A substantial beginning means at least twenty-five (25) percent of the total work involved is completed.

Public Works and Safety (Board) at a public hearing to be held Tine 15

All, 414 Main Street, Hobart, Indiana, 46342. This will be a public hearing at which time you will have the opportunity to appear, present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, present arguments and state your case to the Board. This is the only notice that you will receive regarding your hearing. Be advised that the Enforcement Authority will be seeking an Order from the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety to proceed as indicated above on your property or the property indicated herein where you have a substantial property interest.

You have the right to appeal the findings of this Order with the City of Hobart Board of

At the conclusion of your hearing, the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety may make findings and take action to affirm the Order issued by the Enforcement Authority, rescind the Order issued by the Enforcement Authority or modify the Order issued by the Enforcement Authority. If the person or persons to whom the Order was issued are not present at the hearing, the Board may modify the Order in only a manner that makes the terms less stringent.

Please notify us of your intention to appear before the Board to dispute our findings at least ten (10) working days prior to your above scheduled hearing so that we may add you to our Agenda.

If you choose to ignore the Order and your scheduled opportunity to appear before the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety, the Board shall take whatever action necessary to ensure the unsafe buildings or structures located on your unsafe premises are made to comply with the Ordinance. Further, if the Board finds that there is a willful failure to comply

with the Order, in addition to affirming the Order, the Board may impose a civil penalty in addition to other penalties imposed under the Ordinance and State Law.

REPORT OF INVESTIGATION (ORTarior)

After arriving at the property, it is evident that the gutters need cleaned out. The brick has some signs of algae/moss growing on it. All the windows are intact. The roof appears to be in average condition and I can not see any easily visible foundation or structural issues from the front of the house. I was able to get a few photos of the interior of the garage and bedrooms from the front windows.

As I walked to the back of the house, I noticed the fence falling over on the East side (rear) of the property. There are two piles of brick stacked on the property. The rear deck is covered with debris and plywood. The gutters on the addition are falling down and the soffit is rotted. There was an old sign posted on the rear door indicating not to enter due to the property being treated for mice.

Overall, the house itself does not have any easily visible structural or foundation damage. The rear Alling tion.

Columnia Recorded addition is in poor condition with the falling gutters and rotting soffit. The deck needs to be cleaned off in order to better determine it's condition.


