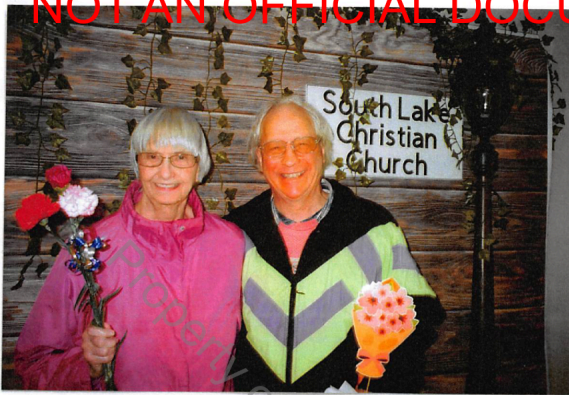
Straight to the kitchen, and never breathed a word of this for the rest of our lives together!

Lake Co. Clerk Arredondo resigns

Health concerns after fall led to decision to quit

Lake County Clerk Lorenzo Arredondo resigned from his office Thursday because of health struggles following a fall earlier this year.

In a letter submitted to Lake County Democratic Party Chair-

man Jim Wieser, Arredondo's three guardians said they made the announcement "with a heavy heart" because Arredondo has served the county for decades.

"Due to his recent health ailments, it is not possible for the Honorable Lorenzo Arredondo to continue his duties as Clerk of the Lake Circuit/Superior Court," the letter reads.

"Serving the people of Lake County for over 40 years has been one of the most rewarding experiences for him both personally and professionally. He loved every

minute of it."

On Jan. 13, Arredondo slipped home and suffered a head injury.

Arredondo, 80, is finishing his first four-year term for clerk, a clerk, he oversees 17 courts in Crown Point, Gary, East Chicago and Hammond, 12 offices and serves on the Lake County Election and Voter Registration board.

Prior to his election as judge for Arredondo served as a judge for 34 years.

Lake County Democratic Party Chairman Jim Wieser said he read

the letter with a heavy heart.

"We had the honor of knowing him all the years he served," Wieser said. "He was a gentleman's gentleman. He's an icon in Lake County Government and in our party."

Wieser said he will hold a caucus to replace Arredondo. Under state law, Wieser said he has 30 days to hold the caucus but he plans to hold the vote sooner.

Mike Brown won the party's nomination in November for the clerk's office, so Wieser said he hopes Brown will participate in the caucus.

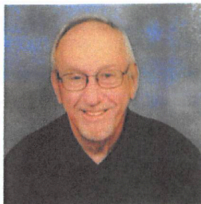

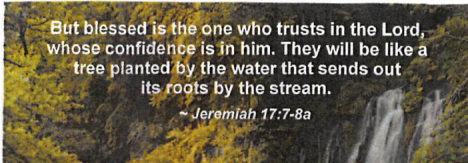
