

### LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (Freddie Mac), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, having an office for the conduct of business at 8250 Jones Branch Drive, McLean, VA 22102, constitutes and appoints: DYCK-O'NEAL, INC. (Dyck-O'Neal), a Texas corporation with an office for the conduct of business in Dallas, Texas, its true and lawful Attorney, and in its name, place and stead and for its use and benefit, to take the following actions with respect to Promissory Notes (secured and unsecured), Liens, Mortgages, Judgments, and

1. To endorse, execute, acknowledge, transfer, and otherwise, in any and all respects, deal with any promissory note, loan agreement, including, without limitation, the ability to negotiate, transfer, or assign any such agreements to any third party or third parties and/or to Freddie Mac or its designee;
2. To execute, assign, acknowledge, transfer, and otherwise, in any and all respects, deal with any judgments, security agreements, security instruments, and lien interests including, without limitation, the ability to sell, transfer, or assign any such agreements to any third party or third parties and/or Freddie Mac or its designee;
3. To collect, demand, and take any other action necessary or desirable to collect all principal, interest, and other sums of money that may now be or hereafter become due and owing pursuant to agreements with borrowers, including, without limitation, the ability to pursue and collect on any delinquency judgments, receive, endorse, cash, negotiate, and otherwise deal with all checks, money orders, and other forms of payment of any kind and to satisfy any and all such agreements.
4. To exercise any right, power or privilege under any security agreements, security instruments, lien interests, or documents of any kind, including, without limitation, taking any action to enforce, execute upon, exercise any power of sale, release, and satisfy any and all such security agreements, security instruments, lien interests, or other instruments or documents; and
5. To transfer and convey to any third parties, and/or to Freddie Mac or its designee, any property which was security for the repayment of loans in the Freddie Mac Portfolio and in furtherance thereof, without limitation, to execute, deliver, and record documents of conveyance concerning such property.

The undersigned gives to said Attorney-in-Fact full power and authority to execute such instruments as if the undersigned were personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming that all said attorney-in-fact shall lawfully do or cause to be done by authority hereof.

Third parties without actual notice may rely upon the power granted under this Limited Power of Attorney upon the exercise of such power of the attorney-in-fact that all conditions precedent to such exercise of power have been satisfied and that this Limited Power of Attorney has not been revoked unless an instrument of revocation has been recorded.
